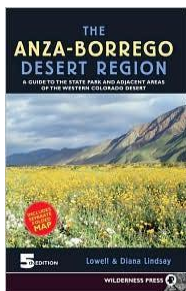

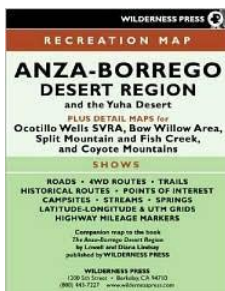

ANZA-BORREGO DESERT MAP, 3rd Edition

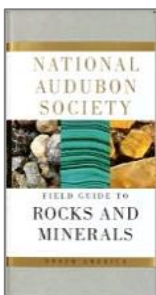
